Sumner Fredericksburg FFA Wins 2014 Iowa FFA Milk Quality and Products Career Development

The 2014 Iowa FFA Milk Quality & Products Career Development Event was held at ISU, Ames on Saturday, August 23, 2014. Fourteen teams and fifty individuals participated in this year's Career Development Event designed to provide students an opportunity to display their knowledge and skills in the area of milk quality and dairy foods.

The Sumner-Fredericksburg FFA was named the Iowa Champion FFA Milk Quality & Products Team. Team members included: Erika Ackerman, Claire Egan, Dustin Mattke, and Lindsey Bouska. Ms. Meghan Bond is the Agriculture Education instructor and FFA advisor. The champion team will compete in the National FFA Milk Quality & Products Career Development Event during the National FFA Convention in Louisville, Kentucky, this October.

The Reserve Champion Team in Dairy Foods Judging was the Cascade FFA, Cascade. Team members included: Alex Foust, Mikaela Gehl, Carolyn Trumm, and David Turnis. Mr. Milt Luckstead is the Agriculture Education instructor and FFA advisor. Brooke Sieren from Keota FFA, Keota was the Champion Individual.
