2016 National FFA Convention and Expo, October 19 – 22

INDIANAPOLIS, IN--The 89th National FFA Convention & Expo celebrated its first year of a nine-year commitment in Indianapolis beginning October 19. More than 60,000 FFA members and guests from throughout the United States, Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands were in attendance at this year's event, which ran through October 22.

This year, the theme of the convention and expo was "Transform Purpose to Action." The national officer team was excited to share this with all of those in attendance.

The convention and expo kicked off with the National FFA Band leading a grand march down Georgia Street in downtown Indianapolis on Wednesday, October 19. The march ended at Bankers Life Fieldhouse and ushered in the start of the opening session. Eight general sessions were held in the fieldhouse. On the morning of Saturday, October 22, the eighth general session was held in Lucas Oil Stadium where American FFA Degrees, the highest degree for an FFA member, were bestowed upon more than 3,000 members.

The Iowa FFA Association was represented by 3,074 attendees involved in all facets of the event. The following is a summary of results and accomplishments of Iowa FFA members in the respective national events.

Agriscience Fair

The Agriscience Fair is for FFA members who are interested in the science and technology of agriculture. Students can compete in 24 divisions across 6 systems areas: Animal; Environmental & Natural Resources; Food Products & Processing; Plant; Power, Structural, & Technical; and Social. Divisions are set based on junior (grades 7-9) and senior (grades 10-12) projects and whether the project is conducted by an individual or a pair.
