2017 National FFA Convention and Expo, October 25 – 28

INDIANAPOLIS, IN--The 90th National FFA Convention & Expo celebrated its second year of a nine-year commitment in Indianapolis beginning October 25. More than 65,000 FFA members and guests from throughout the United States, Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands were in attendance at this year's event, which ran through October 28.

This year, the theme of the convention and expo was "I Can. We Will." The national officer team was excited to share this with all of those in attendance.

The convention and expo kicked off with the National FFA Band leading a grand march down Georgia Street in downtown Indianapolis on Wednesday, October 25. The march ended at Bankers Life Fieldhouse and ushered in the start of the opening session. Eight general sessions were held in the fieldhouse. On the morning of Saturday, October 28, the eighth general session was held in Lucas Oil Stadium where American FFA Degrees, the highest degree for an FFA member, were bestowed upon more than 4,000 members.

The Iowa FFA Association was represented by over 3,000 attendees involved in all facets of the event. The following is a summary of results and accomplishments of Iowa FFA members in the respective national events.

Erica Baier is National FFA Secretary

Students from Arizona, California, Georgia, Iowa, Kentucky, and Oklahoma have bene elected by delegates throughout the United States to serve on the 2017-18 National FFA Officer team. Erica Baier, an agricultural education major at Iowa State University and FFA member from the Earlham FFA chapter, was elected national secretary.

National officers commit to a year of service to the National FFA Organization. Each officer travels more than 100,000 national and international miles to interact with business and industry leaders, thousands of FFA members and teachers, corporate sponsors, government and education officials, state FFA leaders, the general public, and more. The team will lead personal growth and leadership training conferences for FFA members throughout the country and help set policies that will guide the future of FFA and promote agricultural literacy.

Baier is the third FFA member from Iowa to be elected to National Office in the last five years and served the Iowa FFA Association as the 2015-16 South Central State Vice President. The previous two National FFA Officers from Iowa were Abrah Meyer (2014-15 Iowa FFA President) and Steven Brockshus (2012-13 Iowa FFA President).

Kellie Einck is American Star in Placement Winner

Each year at the National FFA Convention & Expo, four FFA members are honored with American Star Awards for outstanding accomplishments in FFA and agricultural education.

The American Star Awards, including American Star Farmer, American Star in Agribusiness, American Star in Agricultural Placement and American Star in Agriscience, are presented to FFA members who demonstrate outstanding agricultural skills and competencies through completion of an SAE. A required activity in FFA, an SAE allows students to learn by doing, by either owning or operating an agricultural business, working or serving an internship at an agriculture-based business or conducting an agriculture-based scientific experiment and reporting results.

Sixteen American Star Award finalists from throughout the U.S. are nominated by a panel of judges who then interview the finalists during the national convention and expo. Four are named winners and receive cash awards totaling \$4,000. Einck is the first star winner from Iowa in 19 years (Andrew Tygrett, 1998).

Agriscience Fair

The Agriscience Fair is for FFA members who are interested in the science and technology of agriculture. Students can compete in 36 divisions across 6 systems areas: Animal; Environmental & Natural Resources; Food Products & Processing; Plant; Power, Structural, & Technical; and Social. Divisions are set based on junior (grades 7-8), intermediate (grades 9-10) and senior (grades 10-12) projects and whether the project is conducted by an individual or a pair.
