MUSCATINE FFA WINS IOWA FFA AGRICULTURAL MECHANICS & TECHNOLOGY CDE

The Muscatine FFA Chapter from Muscatine was named the Champion Team in the annual Iowa FFA Agricultural Mechanics Career Development Event held at Iowa State University in Ames on June 7, 2018. Members of the first place team included: Samuel Reinier, Patrick Pendleton, Andrew Van Nice, and Brandyn Beemblossom. Their agriculture education instructors and FFA advisors are Mr. Sam Paul, Mr. Dave Tometich, and Ms Ashley Wiebe. They will represent Iowa at the National Agricultural Mechanics & Technology Career Development Event at Indianapolis, Indiana, in October. The West Lyon FFA Chapter from Inwood was named the Reserve Champion Team. Members of the second place team included: Gabe Knobloch, Levi Metzger, Lucas Moser, and Tyren Ulmer. Their agriculture education instructors and FFA advisors are Ms. Shauna Kill and Mr. Craig Winquist. Andrew Van Nice, Muscatine FFA, Muscatine, was named the High Individual Overall in the competition.

FFA teams including 81 individuals from 23 chapters participated in this year's Career Development Event designed to provide the student an opportunity to display their agricultural knowledge and skills in the area of Agricultural Mechanics & Technology. Activities included demonstration of skills, problem solving, and knowledge application in agricultural machinery equipment, metals and welding, structures, environmental and natural resources, and electrical systems.
