Little Switzerland FFA Wins 2018 Iowa FFA Dairy Cattle CDE

The 2018 Iowa FFA Dairy Cattle Career Development Event was held in conjunction with the Youth Dairy Classic in Manchester on Saturday, September 8, 2018. Eighteen teams and sixty-three individuals participated in this year's Career Development Event designed to provide students an opportunity to display their knowledge and skills in the area of dairy cattle selection and management.

The Little Switzerland FFA Chapter located in Waukon was named the Iowa Champion FFA Dairy Cattle Team. Team members included: Kaylee Gibbs, Grace Howe, Cayla Nolting, and Faith Palmer. Their agriculture education instructor and FFA advisor is Ms. Jessica O'Connor. The champion team will compete in the National FFA Dairy Cattle Career Development Event during the National FFA Convention in Indianapolis, Indiana this October.
