About Middle School Workshop @ State Convention

Each year, a workshop is held exclusively for middle school students at the annual Iowa FFA Leadership Conference.

The Middle School Workshop is typically scheduled for the Tuesday afternoon of the annual state leadership conference.

The workshop is open to any 7th or 8th grade student. The program has a two-year rotation of curriculum, which includes three different 45-minute workshops running concurrently.

All participants must be registered attendees (student registration rate) at the Iowa FFA Leadership Conference. All attendees must complete the requested consent/waiver that all student attendees at the conference complete.
