Ferris George Rising Star Award

I. Overview

The Ferris George Rising Star Award is presented in memory of Ferris George, a charter member of the National FFA Organization, a member of the United FFA Alumni, and supporter of agriculture. The purpose of the award is to recognize FFA members who during their freshman year exhibited outstanding leadership.

II. Rules

- 1. Applicants wishing to be considered as a Rising Star Finalist shall advance a completed application (postmarked) on or before February 12^{th} .
- 2. Only one applicant per chapter per year.
- 3. Member must have been an outstanding High School Freshman member from the previous school year currently in his/her Sophomore year.
- 4. Member must be in good standing with the local, state, and national FFA.
- 5. Member must have shown outstanding leadership growth.
- 6. Member must have an established SAE program.
- 7. Member must be currently enrolled in agricultural education or have taken a one-semester class in agricultural education during the current school year.
- 8. Applicants must utilize the official award application provided by the state.
- 9. One finalist per FFA District will be selected based on the application. Finalists will then participate in an interview at the Iowa FFA Leadership Conference.
- 10. Each finalist shall submit their Supervised Agricultural Experience (SAE) records at the time of the interview process for verification of their SAE by the interview committee.

III. Recommended Interview Process

- 1. The interview committee will consist of individuals provided by the Iowa FFA Alumni, Iowa FFA Foundation and Iowa FFA Association.
- 2. The interview process may consist of two rounds. No interview may exceed 15 minutes.
- 3. Sample SAE questions to consider are as follows:
 - Describe your SAE project.
 - What have you learned from your SAE?
 - What are your plans for your SAE in the future?
 - What has been the biggest challenge you have faced in your SAE?
 - What help have you sought out or been given with your SAE?
- 4. Sample Alumni questions to consider are as follows:
 - What do you know about FFA Alumni?
 - Do you have to have been an FFA member to be in the Alumni?
 - Do you have a local Alumni Chapter? If so how have they helped your FFA Chapter?
- 5. Sample FFA questions to consider are as follows:
 - Why did you join FFA?
 - What encouragement would you give to someone thinking about joining FFA?
 - What does your FFA jacket mean to you?
 - What is the best piece of advice an older member of your chapter has given you?
