Through one easy application process, the lowa Farm Bureau Federation (IFBF) and many of its 100 county Farm Bureaus offer a variety of scholarships at the state and local level to future college students, ranging from \$250 - \$2,500 annually.

Eligibility Requirements

- Be a current Farm Bureau member in good standing with the county Farm Bureau and IFBF as a family member or individual. To become a member, visit www.lowaFarmBureau.com/join.
- Be a graduating high school student with a minimum grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale or equivalent. (Current high school transcript must be provided.)
- Accepted in an accredited institution of higher education (i.e., technical college, junior college, community college, college, or university).
- Seeking a major and/or minor in an ag-related field or one that supports rural lowa.
- Involved in school activities (i.e., 4-H, FFA, Honor Society, Student Council, etc.).
- Demonstrated leadership abilities, community involvement, and volunteer efforts.
- Submit an essay outlining commitment to agriculture and rural lowa.
- Provide two letters of recommendation (i.e., teacher, counselor, community leader, or clergy).
