- 3. The ballot will be announced the following business day upon completion of the interviews.
- 4. Students placed on the ballot or nominated from the floor will present a speech, no longer than two minutes at the North Central District FFA Convention. They will also answer two questions with a limited answer time of one minute per question.
- 5. The 2020-2021 District FFA officer team will be announced at the conclusion of the 2020 District FFA Convention scheduled for March 7, 2020.

It is important to realize that the interview and election process is extremely challenging and is intended to result in a team that will work and learn together. Regardless of the outcome of this process it is important for each individual to benefit the interview experience, in addition to the fact that you applied for this office to serve the members.
