The first place chapter for the event was the Montezuma FFA Chapter. Their agriculture education instructor and FFA advisor is Mr. Rick Swenson. The second place chapter for the event was the North Fayette FFA Chapter at West Union. Their agriculture education instructor and FFA advisor is Mr. Ryan Holthaus.

Teams participating in this event were composed of seven members organized to act out the duties of an officer team. Teams were required to demonstrate opening ceremonies, act out two parliamentary procedure abilities, and successfully close a meeting.
