Washington FFA Wins 2013 Iowa FFA Milk Quality and Products Career Development Event

The 2013 Iowa FFA Milk Quality & Products Career Development Event was held at ISU, Ames on Saturday, August 24, 2013. Twenty teams and seventy-one individuals participated in this year's Career Development Event designed to provide students an opportunity to display their knowledge and skills in the area of milk quality and dairy foods.

Mr. Duane Van Winkle is the Agriculture Education instructor and FFA advisor. The champion team will compete in the National FFA Milk Quality & Products Career Development Event during the National FFA Convention in Louisville, Kentucky, this October.
