They will represent Iowa at the National Nursery/Landsacpe Career Development Event at Louisville, Kentucky, in October. The Wapello FFA Chapter was named the Reserve Champion Team. FFA teams from 13 chapters including 42 individuals participated in this year's Career Development Event designed to provide students an opportunity to display their agricultural knowledge and skills in the area of Nursery/Landscape. The event consisted of a general knowledge exam, a landscape estimation practicum, a customer service activity, identification of nursery materials (plants, disorders, equipment and supplies), and situation assessment and solution.
