Montezuma FFA Wins Iowa FFA Farm Business Management CDE

The Montezuma FFA Chapter from Montezuma was named the Champion Team in the annual Iowa FFA Farm Management Career Development Event virtually on November 12, 2020. The Belle Plaine FFA Chapter from Belle Plaine was named the Reserve Champion Team. Members of the second place team included: Carson Adams, Zach Brecht, Jared Ward, and Kamryn Hoskey. Their agriculture education instructor and FFA advisor is Mr. Steve Eskildsen. Michael Dejong, Montezuma FFA, Montezuma, was named the High Individual Overall in the competition. The Montezuma FFA Chapter from Montezuma was the winner of the Team Participation Activity.

FFA teams from 26 chapters participated in this year's Career Development Event designed to provide the student an opportunity to display their agricultural knowledge and skills in the area of Farm Management. The 95 individuals who participated in the event each completed an objective test which had three sections: economic principles, records and analysis, and risk management. All team members worked together to solve a problem related to break even analysis.
