CLEAR LAKE FFA WINS IOWA FFA VETERINARY SCIENCE CDE

The Clear Lake FFA Chapter from Clear Lake was named the Champion Team in the annual Iowa FFA Veterinary Science Career Development Event held at Iowa State University in Ames on June 10, 2021. Members of the first place team included: Emma Pingel, Maycee Wilkie, Kjersten Ouverson, and Ashlyn Fread. Their agriculture education instructor and FFA advisor is Mrs. Elisa Russ-Poggemiller. They will represent Iowa at the National Veterinary Science Career Development Event at Indianapolis, Indiana, in October. The Wilton FFA Chapter from Wilton was named the Reserve Champion Team. Members of the second place team included: Elizabeth Daufeldt, Emma Hartman, Taylor Schult, and Kiley Langley. Their agriculture education instructor and FFA advisor is Mr. Gary Bruns. Ashlyn Fread, Clear Lake FFA, was named the High Individual Overall in the competition.

FFA teams from 24 chapters participated in this year's Career Development Event designed to provide the students an opportunity to display their agricultural knowledge and skills in the area of Veterinary Science. The 95 individuals completed a general knowledge examination focusing on veterinary science. The team members also completed a written scenario and prepared a video focusing on proper veterinary clinical practices.
