WEST LYON FFA WINS IOWA FFA AGRICULTURAL MECHANICS & TECHNOLOGY CDE

The West Lyon FFA Chapter from Inwood was named the Champion Team in the annual Iowa FFA Agricultural Mechanics Career Development Event held at Iowa State University in Ames on June 16, 2022. Members of the first place team included: Nathan Knapp, Kendon Knoblock, and Jesse Wulf. Their agriculture education instructors and FFA advisors are Ms. Katherine Newhouse and Mrs. Shauna Steiner. They will represent Iowa at the National Agricultural Mechanics & Technology Career Development Event at Indianapolis, Indiana, in October. The Monticello FFA Chapter from Monticello was named the Reserve Champion Team. Members of the second place team included: Owen Thomas, Cooper Wickman, and Landon Orcutt. Their agriculture education instructor and FFA advisor is Mr. Eric Schmitt. Justin Agnitsch, Midland FFA, Wyoming, was named the High Individual Overall in the competition.

FFA teams including 112 individuals from 32 chapters participated in this year's Career Development Event designed to provide the student an opportunity to display their agricultural knowledge and skills in the area of Agricultural Mechanics & Technology. Activities included demonstration of skills, problem solving, and knowledge application in agricultural machinery equipment, metals and welding, structures, environmental and natural resources, and electrical systems.
