96th Iowa FFA State Leadership Conference

AMES, IA - The Iowa FFA Public Speaking Leadership Development Event (LDE) was held at the Iowa State Center, Ames, on Monday, April 15, 2024. 12 individuals participated in this year's LDE. The first place individual for the event was Nora Mitchell from the Hudson FFA Chapter. Their agriculture education instructor and FFA advisor is Mr. Dennis Deppe. The second place individual for the event was Anna Mussig from the GMG FFA Chapter at Garwin. Their agriculture education instructor and FFA advisor is Mrs. Erin Murty.

This event is designed to develop rural and agricultural leadership, to provide for member participation in agricultural public speaking activities and to stimulate interest along such lines. The prepared public speaking event requires participants to write and deliver a six-to-eight minute speech in front of a panel of judges. Scoring is based on the written manuscript, the delivery of the speech and the answers to questions.
