North Fayette Valley FFA Wins 2025 Iowa FFA Dairy Cattle CDE

The 2025 Iowa FFA Dairy Cattle Career Development Event was held in conjunction with the Youth Dairy Classic in Manchester on Friday, September 5, 2025. Thirty-five teams and 134 individuals participated in this year's Career Development Event designed to provide students an opportunity to display their knowledge and skills in the area of dairy cattle selection and management.

The North Fayette Valley FFA Chapter located in West Union was named the Iowa Champion FFA Dairy Cattle Team. Team members included: Brock Soppe, Lily Holthaus, Lila Moore, and Kyson Moss. Their agriculture education instructor and FFA advisor is Mr. Ryan Holthaus. The champion team will compete in the National FFA Dairy Cattle Career Development Event during the National FFA Convention in Indianapolis, Indiana this October.

The Reserve Champion Team in Dairy Judging was the West Dubuque FFA Chapter located in Epworth. Team members included: Madalynn Arnold, Ana Rauen, Alex Lawler, and Keaton Junk. Their agriculture education instructor and FFA advisor is Mr. Matt Lansing. Brock Soppe from West Union was the Champion Individual. Braden Ronnebaum from Delhi was the Reserve Champion Individual.
