2009 IOWA FFA PUBLIC SPEAKING CAREER DEVELOPMENT EVENT

81st Iowa FFA State Leadership Conference

The Iowa FFA Public Speaking Leadership Event was held at the Events Center, Des Moines, on Thursday, April 16, 2009. Twelve individuals participated in this year's Career Development Event. The first place individual for the event was Jamie Leistikow from the Wapsie Valley FFA Chapter at Fairbank. Their agriculture education instructor and FFA advisor is Ms. Ellen Doese. The second place individual for the event was Daniel Venteicher from the Edgewood-Colesburg FFA Chapter. Their agriculture education instructor and FFA advisor is Mr. Brent Ness.

This event is designed to develop rural and agricultural leadership, to provide for member participation in agricultural public speaking activities and to stimulate interest along such lines. The prepared public speaking event requires participants to write and deliver a six-to-eight minute speech in front of a panel of judges. Scoring is based on the written manuscript, the delivery of the speech and the answers to questions. The 2003-04 Iowa FFA Officers, through the Iowa FFA Foundation, sponsored this year's event.
