Charles City FFA Wins Iowa FFA Food Science CDE

The Charles City FFA Chapter from Charles City was named the Champion Team in the annual Iowa FFA Food Science Career Development Event held at Iowa State University in Ames on June 6, 2013. Members of the first place team included: Bailee Hejna, Ashley Vance, Myla Meyer, and Tate Jaeger. Their agriculture education instructor and FFA advisor is Mr. Jim Lundberg. They will represent Iowa at the National Food Science Career Development Event at Louisville, Kentucky, in October. The LaPorte-Dysart FFA Chapter from LaPorte City was named the Reserve Champion Team. Members of the second place team included: Eli Kautz, Cole Moody, Abby Ollendieck, and Maria Wrage. Their agriculture education instructor and FFA advisor is Mr. Louis Beck. Eli Kautz, LaPorte-Dysart FFA, LaPorte City, was named the High Individual Overall in the competition.

FFA teams from 19 chapters participated in this year's Career Development Event designed to provide the student an opportunity to display their agricultural knowledge and skills in the area of Food Science. The 70 individuals who participated in the event completed several activities including demonstration of skills and problem solving in dealing with consumer concerns, food safety and sanitation, aroma identification, taste testing, and product differences. A written examination was included along with a team product development competition.

The Iowa FFA Food Science & Technology Career Development Event was made possible with sponsorship by the Iowa State University Department of Food Science & Human Nutrition and Cookies Food Products through the Iowa FFA Foundation. The top individual receives a \$500 scholarship from the Iowa State University Department of Food Science & Human Nutrition if the student chooses to major in Food Science at Iowa State
