NORTH SCOTT FFA WINS 2017 IOWA FFA MILK QUALITY AND PRODUCTS CDE

The 2017 Iowa FFA Milk Quality & Products Career Development Event was held at Manchester on Saturday, September 9, 2017. Twenty teams and sixty-three individuals participated in this year's Career Development Event designed to provide students an opportunity to display their knowledge and skills in the area of milk quality and dairy foods.

The North Scott FFA, Eldridge was named the Iowa Champion FFA Milk Quality & Products Team. Team members included: Dylan Ballard, Grace Bjustrom, Dylan Engelbrecht, and Chloe Engelbrecht.
