Iowa FFA Announces 2017 Stars Over Iowa Finalists

ANKENY, Iowa--The 2017 Stars Over Iowa Finalists were selected for recognition as part of the 89th Iowa FFA State Leadership Conference at Hilton Coliseum in Ames, Iowa, April 9-11, 2017. Eighteen finalists were selected in three different areas: Agricultural Placement, Agribusiness, and Agricultural Production. The finalists were selected from a pool of 646 FFA members that will earn the Iowa FFA Degree—the highest honor the Iowa FFA Association can bestow upon an FFA member.

The star awards recognize students who have developed outstanding agricultural skills and competencies through their career development programs and demonstrated outstanding management skills. These finalists will be interviewed and an overall winner in each area will be announced on stage during the 4th General Session of the Iowa FFA State Leadership Conference Tuesday, April 11th.
