# **2018** National FFA Convention and Expo, October 24<sup>th</sup> – 27<sup>th</sup>

INDIANAPOLIS, IN--The 91<sup>st</sup> National FFA Convention & Expo celebrated its third year of a nine-year commitment in Indianapolis beginning October 24<sup>th</sup>. More than 69,000 FFA members and guests from throughout the United States, Puerto Rico, and the U.S. Virgin Islands were in attendance at this year's event, which ran through October 27<sup>th</sup>.

This year, the theme of the convention and expo was "Just One". One moment, one encounter, one opportunity is all it takes to radically change the course of a person's life. The National FFA Officer team was excited to share in the experience of the National FFA Convention and Expo with all attendees.

The convention and expo kicked off with the National FFA Band leading a grand march down Georgia Street in downtown Indianapolis on Wednesday, October 24<sup>th</sup>. The march ended at Bankers Life Fieldhouse and ushered in the start of the opening session. Eight general sessions will be held in the fieldhouse. On the morning of Saturday, October 27<sup>th</sup>, the eighth general session will be held in Lucas Oil Stadium where American FFA Degrees, the highest degree for an FFA member, were bestowed upon more than 4,000 members.

The Iowa FFA Association is expecting representation from over 3,000 attendees involved in all facets of the event. The following is a summary of results and accomplishments of Iowa FFA members in the respective national events.

# Erica Baier, Retired 2017-2018 National FFA Secretary

Erica Baier, an agricultural education major at Iowa State University and FFA member from the Earlham FFA chapter, completed her term as the National FFA Secretary. She delivered her retiring address titled "Fight the Fear" during the seventh session of the conference on Friday, October 26<sup>th</sup>.

Baier was the second FFA member from Iowa to be elected to National FFA Secretary in the history of FFA. She previously served the Iowa FFA Association as the 2015-16 South Central State Vice President.

# Eric Koehlmoos is American Star in Agriscience Winner

Each year at the National FFA Convention & Expo, four FFA members are honored with American Star Awards for outstanding accomplishments in FFA and agricultural education.

The American Star Awards, including American Star Farmer, American Star in Agribusiness, American Star in Agricultural Placement and American Star in Agriscience, are presented to FFA members who demonstrate outstanding agricultural skills and competencies through completion of an SAE. A required activity in FFA, an SAE allows students to learn by doing, by either owning or operating an agricultural business, working or serving an internship at an agriculture-based business or conducting an agriculture-based scientific experiment and reporting results.

Out of sixteen American Star Award finalists from throughout the U.S., four are named winners and receive cash awards totaling \$4,000. Eric Koehlmoos of the South O'Brien FFA Chapter was named 2018 Star in Agriscience.

# **Agriscience Fair**

The Agriscience Fair is for FFA members who are interested in the science and technology of agriculture. Students can compete in 36 divisions across 6 systems areas: Animal; Environmental & Natural Resources; Food Products & Processing; Plant; Power, Structural, & Technical; and Social. Divisions are set based on junior (grades 7-8), intermediate (grades 9-10) and senior (grades 10-12) projects and whether the project is conducted by an individual or a pair.
