2019 National FFA Convention and Expo, October 30 – November 2

INDIANAPOLIS, IN--The 92nd National FFA Convention & Expo will celebrate its fourth year of a nine-year commitment in Indianapolis beginning October 30th. More than 65,000 FFA members and guests from throughout the United States, Puerto Rico, and the U.S. Virgin Islands are expected to be in attendance at this year's event, which will run through November 2nd.

The convention and expo will kick off in Indianapolis, Indiana on Wednesday, October 30th. Eight general sessions will be held at Lucas Oil Stadium. On the morning of Saturday, November 2nd, the eighth general session will be held where American FFA Degrees, the highest degree for an FFA member, were bestowed upon more than 4,000 members.

The Iowa FFA Association is expecting representation from over 3,000 attendees involved in all facets of the event. The following is a summary of results and accomplishments of Iowa FFA members in the respective national events.

Peyton Schmitt is Iowa's National Officer Candidate

Peyton Schmitt, an Agricultural and Life Sciences Education major at Iowa State University and FFA member from the Lone Tree FFA Chapter, is Iowa's National Officer Candidate. National officers commit to a year of service to the National FFA Organization. Each officer travels more than 100,000 national and international miles to interact with business and industry leaders, thousands of FFA members and teachers, corporate sponsors, government and education officials, state FFA leaders, the general public, and more. The team will lead personal growth and leadership training conferences for FFA members throughout the country and help set policies that will guide the future of FFA and promote agricultural literacy. The 2019-2020 National Officer team will be announced at the end of the Eighth General Session on Saturday, November 2nd. Schmitt previously served the Iowa FFA Association as the 2017-18 State Secretary.

Agriscience Fair National Finalists

The Agriscience Fair is for FFA members who are interested in the science and technology of agriculture. Students can compete in 36 divisions across 6 systems areas: Animal; Environmental & Natural Resources; Food Products & Processing; Plant; Power, Structural, & Technical; and Social. Divisions are set based on junior (grades 7-8), intermediate (grades 9-10) and senior (grades 10-12) projects and whether the project is conducted by an individual or a pair.

Only 3-star chapters are eligible for premier chapter awards. DeWitt Central FFA will compete in the Premier Chapter: Growing Leaders category.

Four "National Finalists" are selected for each of the award areas and will go on to compete for a national proficiency award.
